Performers' Biographies

Arthur Avilés '87 received a BA in Drama/Dance under Jean Churchill, Lenore Latimer, Susan Osberg, Aileen Passloff, and Albert Reid. He was also awarded the Charles Flint Kellogg Award in Arts and Letters and an honorary doctor of fine arts degree from his alma mater. He was honored to have entered into a series of collaborations with Passloff, including an original dance she created for him using the drawings of Remy Charlip. Together, they appeared in two Marta Renzi films, Arthur & Aileen and Her Magnum Opus.

Charlotte Hendrickson '07 is a dancer and choreographer. Over the past 16 years, Hendrickson has worked closely with Aileen Passloff, and had the honor of learning dances made for Passloff by James Waring and Remy Charlip. Currently, she is dancing with Catherine Gallant. Hendrickson has created her own business coaching movement, and also teaches yoga and tantra.

EmmaGrace Skove-Epes '08 studied with Aileen Passloff, Maria Simpson, Jean Churchill, Leslie Arlette Boyce, Lenore Latimer, Susan Osberg, and Peggy Florin. She is a freelance dancer, choreographer, dance educator, and caregiver, who has performed the works of choreographers including Jodi Melnick, Jon Kinzel, Jonathan González, RoseAnne Spradlin, Peniel Guerrier, Kathy Westwater, and Nadia Tykulsker. Her own work has been shown at venues throughout New York City. Passloff was a friend and mentor to Skove-Epes, who, from September through November 2020, was one of Passloff's caregivers and worked with her on archiving parts of her large body of choreographic work.
